GIS Lab, 2024 - Present

The **SORADI GIS Lab** provides geospatial infrastructure and expertise, partnering with institutions and researchers to drive spatial analytics, climate data science, conservation planning, and climate-informed decision-making across the region.

UCL Press Published Book, 2024 - 2027

Alongside our partners, SORADI is preparing a UCL Press edited volume convening international scholars to advance applied knowledge on pastoralist climate adaptation in Somaliland.

Mitigating Climate-Sensitive Disease, 2024 - 2029

DVSOMA delivers interdisciplinary analysis of climate-driven vector-borne diseases affecting vulnerable IDP populations, particularly children and pregnant women, generating evidence to inform policy and strengthen surveillance and prevention systems.

BSU Phase IV, 2023 - 2028

SORADI designs and delivers MSc Climate Change Research Practicum under the **Building Stronger Universities** programme, embedding field-based research within graduate training to institutionalise applied climate scholarship.

Climate Change & Resilience, 2022 - 2027

Funded by Danida, the **PACCS** project advances pastoralist resilience in Somaliland, with SORADI delivering locally grounded research, policy analysis, and implementation design to strengthen climate adaptation and sustainable livelihoods.

Analysis of Private Investment Landscape, 2025

Representing local and international investment firms, SORADI examined the progress of conflict-sensitive investment, with a focus on reducing risk and advancing responsible SME growth.

M&E Systems Research, 2023 - 2025

Funded by USAID and implemented with Integrity Global, SORADI conducted primary research and in-depth analysis strengthening existing Monitoring & Evaluation data and advancing evidence-informed frameworks for IDP programming across Somalia.

Climate, Mobility, Policy, 2023

To this [REF publication](#) led by SOAS, we contributed field-based analysis on climate-driven mobility patterns, an interrogation of the policy frameworks, and evidence-based recommendations integrating climate adaptation and conflict considerations into policy and programming.

Climate-Conflict Dynamics, 2021

SORADI produced field-based analysis that shaped climate-security debates, demonstrating how climate stress drives conflict, cooperation, and adaptive governance responses. The resulting [Toda Peace Institute publication](#) now serves as critical reference material.

Tax System Evaluation, 2020

In support of the Ministry of Finance as part of the World Bank's Public Finance Management, we assessed Somaliland's tax system, examining equity, efficiency, and transparency to inform fiscal policy reform.

Capacity-Building, 2019 - 2020

The SORADI Training Institute designed and delivered capacity-building programmes for civil society and public sector institutions across the Horn of Africa.

Expanding Access to Justice, 2019

In partnership with PACT and the American Bar Association, through a USAID-funded project, SORADI developed a model to expand access to justice for marginalised groups residing in IDP camps.

Decentralisation & Accountability, 2016 - 2018

Funded by DFID and in partnership with Mott MacDonald, SORADI examined decentralisation dynamics within Municipal governance, addressing accountability challenges in the Municipality of Hargeisa.

Gender Equality & Social Inclusion, 2015 - 2017

Focused on empowering marginalised groups, the result of this effort is presented in the Emma Grant report titled "[Voice of the Voiceless](#)", produced under the auspices of the IAAAP project.

Third Party Monitoring, 2013 - 2016

In collaboration with IBTCI, SORADI monitored USAID- and DFID-funded projects, applying structured monitoring frameworks to strengthen accountability and transparency.

In support of CARE International-Somalia, SORADI designed and implemented monitoring & evaluation systems to enhance project effectiveness and impact assessment.

Law & Development, 2010 - 2011

SORADI collaborated with the Law and Development Partnership (LDP) to deliver a Danida-commissioned study titled "Evaluation of Danida's Somali-focused programmes in the Horn of Africa."

Institutionalising Democracy, 2009 - 2013

Working closely with the Heinrich Boell Foundation, SORADI developed and implemented this EU-funded project to foster democratic governance and institutional development in the region, resulting in a groundbreaking series of publications.

Media Freedom & Capacity-Building, 2008 - 2013

In partnership with IREX, the University of Oxford, and the London School of Economics, SORADI assessed media sustainability, advocated for press freedom, and developed local media institutions in Somaliland.

Good Governance, 2007 - 2011

SORADI conducted applied research on democratisation and governance processes under IDRC- and Oxfam Novib-funded initiatives, advancing good governance and democratic practice.
